Winemaking Description:

Indigenous fermentation with 50% whole bunches, matured in 50% new French oak barrels, un-fined and unfiltered. Note – Same winemaking practices applied to all

batches.

The Wine:

Light ruby in colour. An airy nose comprised of maraschino cherry laced with both earth and a plethora of floral elements. The texture is sleek, middle weight and superb length.
