2024 Ooh La La Chardonnay



The Story: Chardonnay is the most popular white wine on earth, and, more recently, it has also become the most divisive. The problem is opinion, too much oak, too much MLF, too much acid. Luckily we are not all the same, is it a case of either you like it or you don't? Mmmm, I am not 100% sure that there is no such thing as inherent quality. Truly interesting wine should be complex. It should be both for the heart and for the head. Ooh La La is made in the Lethbridge 'house' style, vivacious and voluptuous but subtle. Made in large format French barrels, partially new, partially old so that we have a subtle influence of oak marrying beautifully with a line of citrus fruit.

The Wine: Fruit for this wine was partially whole bunch pressed and wild fermented in a mixture of new and old large format oak and aged on fine lees. The wine was allowed to undergo 100% wild malolactic conversion before being bottled in December 2024.

A beautifully nose of lemon zest, white peach and lychee with just a hint of baked apple crumble. Pear, apple and lime abound on the palate with a beautiful soft, creamy finish balanced by mouth-watering acidity.
